Stat. 120A.20, subd 2.

\*\*This is a parent whose youngest dependent child will become ineligible to receive assistance under Part A of Title IV of the Social Security Act, no later than 2 years after the date on which the parent applies for assistance under this title; and is employed or underemployed and is experiencing difficulty in obtaining or upgrading employment.
